Biography

Dr. Yan Xiaojun is currently an Associate Professor in Department of Politics and Public Administration and Director of the Research Hub on Institutions of China, at the University of Hong Kong. He receives HKU's Outstanding Teaching Award in 2013. He obtained his Bachelor and Master of Law degrees from Peking University and an A.M. and Ph.D. in political science from Harvard University. He is a comparative political scientist with special expertise in the politics of China.

Dr Yan is the author of three books and co-editor of one edited volume. His articles have appeared in a dozen of leading academic journals. He is the recipient of the 2012 Gordon White Prize by The China Quarterly. His first book on Hong Kong politics is selected as one of the "Ten Best Chinese Books (non-fiction) Published in 2015" by Asia Weekly.
