Duoduo Xu is Assistant Professor of Sociology at the University of Hong Kong (2019-present). Before joining HKU, she was Research Assistant Professor of Social Science and Junior Fellow of Institute for Advanced Study at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (2017-2019). Xu received her PhD in Social Science from HKUST (2017), where she was also trained at the Center for Applied Social and Economic Research (CASER).

Xu's research lies at the intersection of urban sociology, sociology of education, and sociology of work. Her studies are mainly concerned with child development and youth employment issues in Chinese cities, and draw on various longitudinal survey datasets and a range of quantitative methods for causal inference. Xu's work has been published or is forthcoming in *British Journal of Sociology*, *China Quarterly*, *Chinese Sociological Review*, *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*, *Work, Employment and Society*, among others.
