



Professor Yuto Kitamura

Dr. Yuto Kitamura is a Professor at the Graduate School of Education and a Director of the Center for Advanced School Education and Evidence-Based Research at the University of Tokyo. He is also a member of the Board of Education at the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, an Associate Member of the Science Council of Japan, and a Visiting Fellow at the JICA Ogata Sadako Research Institute for Peace and Development. He specializes in comparative education and has been conducting extensive research on the education policies of developing countries, particularly in Southeast Asia (mainly Cambodia). He has worked at UNESCO and taught at Nagoya University and Sophia University. He has served as a Fulbright Scholar at the George Washington University, a Visiting Professor at the University of Dhaka, and a Special Advisor to the Rector of the Royal University of Phnom Penh. He received B.A. in Education (Keio University) and M.A. and Ph.D. both in Education (UCLA).
